ABSTRACT

ORDER

In the G.O.Ms. No. 486 Health, dt. 25.3.80 the Government have issued orders for the reorganisation of the Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine for the effective implementation of Medical care and Public Health Programmes. According to the Re-organised Pattern, the State is divided into 7 Regions ~~and~~ 29 Health Unit Districts. A Regional Assistant Director will be incharge of two or three Revenue Districts covered in the 7 Region Offices. The Government have also sanctioned certain staff towards the implementation of the above re-organisation. The President, Tamilnadu Government Officials' Union has stated that the ministerial staff sanctioned both at the Regions and Health Unit Districts are quite inadequate and that there is hardly any promotional opportunities available to the Ministerial

staff. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also submitted revised proposals for the creation of additional posts of ministerial staff.

2. The Government have examined the request of the Association and the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. The Government sanction the creation/upgradation of the staff at the Regional Organisations and Health Unit Districts for a period of one year from the date of employment as indicated below: A review will be made in March '81 to examine the need for the continuance of the additional staff and upgraded posts:

REGIONAL SET UP:

(Regional Entomological Teams)

Entomological Staff: Additional 2 Units for the two new Regions for the Headquarters at Madurai and Vellore.

Each Unit consists of:

Assistant Entomologist - 2 posts in the scale of pay of
(Senior Entomologists) Rs. 750-50-1350

Laboratory Assistants: 4 posts in the scale of pay of
Rs. 295-5-315-10-475

Field Assistants: 4 posts of Rs. 280-5-320-10-450

Out of the two posts of Accountants sanctioned in Annexure III of G.O.Ms. No. 486 Health and Family Welfare dt. 25.3.80 at the Regional Level, one post of Accountant will be upgraded into that of an Administrative Officer in the scale of pay of Rs. 600-30-750-35-890-40-1050 P.M. Each Administrative Officer will be posted to each Regional Office.

HEALTH UNIT DISTRICTS

1. One post of Office Superintendent in each of the 29 Health Unit Districts in the scale of pay Rs.525-25-675-30-855-35-925 p.m.
2. Out of the four posts of Junior Assistants (including Store-Keepers) sanctioned in Annexure III of G.O.Ms.No.486 Health and Family Welfare dt. 25.3.80 in the District set up one post of Junior Assistant will be upgraded into that of an Assistant in the scale of pay Rs.400-15-490-20-650-25-700 p.m.
3. One post of Typist in each of the District Health Unit in the scale of pay of Rs.350-10-420-15-600 p.m.
3. The holder of the posts sanctioned in para 2 above are eligible to draw in addition to their pay House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowances and other allowances at the rates admissible from time to time under the Public Health Department and orders in force.
4. The expenditure on the staff sanctioned in para 2 above should be debited to "282.A Public Health and Sanitation-AA-Direction and Administration - Schemes in the Five Year Plan II - State Plan - JB Muffusal Administration (DPC 282.AAAJB - 0005)."
5. The Government do not approve the other proposals of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.
6. The details of the administrative powers of the Regional Assistant Directors and of the District Health Officers are mentioned in Annexure I and II respectively to this order instead of those indicated in Annexures IV and V respectively to the Government order read above.

7. As the new posts have to be created at the Regional Offices sanctioned in the G.O. immediately, The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to fill up the posts at once, besides sending proposals for posting of Regional Assistant Directors for the seven Regions and District Health Officers for 29 Health Unit Districts. A report on the action taken should be sent to the Government.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 468 JS(F)/80-1 dt. 26.5.80.

RE-ORGANISATION

Sub: Public Health - Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine - Re-organisation - Formation of 29 Health Unit Districts - Orders - Issued.

ORDER

In G.O.Ms. No.486, Health and Family Welfare Department dated 25.3.80, the Government have issued orders for the re-organisation of Directorate of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, for the effective and purposeful implementation of various Health Schemes. According to the Re-organised pattern, the State will be divided into 7 Regions and 29 Health Unit Districts. A Regional Assistant Director, will be incharge of two or three Revenue Districts which will be covered by 7 Regional Offices.

2. In the Re-organised pattern, there will be 29 Health Unit Districts. The existing 15 District Health Officers will be renamed as Officers of Health Unit Districts. 14 more Offices of Health Unit Districts will be created to make up a total of 29 Health Unit Districts. Each Health Unit District will be under the charge of a District Health Officer. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and Director of Primary Health Centres have been asked to work out the details of the set up ^{of} a Health Unit District in the re-organised set up ~~in the re-organised set~~ and redistribute the 383 Primary Health Centres among them.

3. Accordingly the Directors have furnished the particulars for the formation of 29 Health Unit Districts.

4. The Government have examined the reports of the Directors and they approve the 29 Health Unit Districts

as mentioned in the Annexure of this order.
