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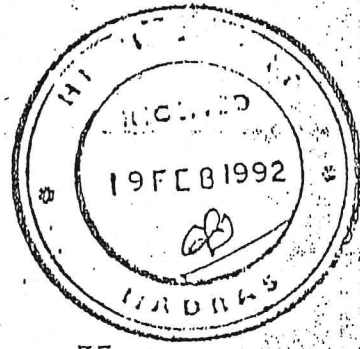

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Clarification raised by the Heads of Department

Reply by the Government

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Whether the Government servants due to retire on 30.4.1992 and drawn a part-final withdrawal during June '91 may be sanctioned another part-final withdrawal to the individual in question without adopting GPF Rules.

No. The interval period of one year between two part-final withdrawal need be looked into for sanction of 90% of part-final withdrawal. Relevant GPF rules should be adopted.

Whether the Rule 15 and 16 of GPF rules are relevant to the sanction of 90% part-final withdrawal.

Not relevant. Paragraph 3 of G.O.Ms.No.535, Finance (Allowances.I), dated 19.7.91 is hereby deleted.

Whether the Accountant-General's authorisation is necessary while allowing 90% of part-final withdrawal during the last four months of service

Authorisation from the Accountant-General is not necessary for sanction of 90% of part-final withdrawal during the last four months of service prior to retirement on superannuation. Amendment to GPF rules will be issued separately in due course.

Note: Pending amendment to the GPF rules, the Govt. servants who apply for part-final withdrawal upto 90% of balance at credit during the last four months before superannuation be permitted to avail the benefit.
