APPENDIX.
NOTIFICATION I.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to
article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of
Madras hereby makes the following rules relating
to the temporary post of Resident Matron, Grade III,
Health Unit, Poonamallee.

RULES

1. The General and Special Rules applicable to the
holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health
Subordinate Services shall apply to the holder of the
temporary post of Resident Matron, Grade II, Health Unit,
Poonamallee.
2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate
category of the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the post shall be.
 - (a) by promotion of the holders of the post of Health
Visitors in the Health Unit, Poonamallee and Malaria Control
Team, Nilambur with a satisfactory record of service for
at least 3 years, or.
 - (b) by direct recruitment if no suitable candidate is
available for appointment by promotion.

4. Appointing authority: The appointing authority shall be the Director of Public Health, Madras.

5. Qualifications (1) No one shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless the person possesses:-

(A) If trained in Great Britain.

(a) A certificate of at least 3 years training in an approved General Hospital of over 100 beds and a certificate of having passed the examination held at the end of the course of training.

(b) a certificate of registration in the General Post of the Register of (i) General Nursing Council of England and Wales or (ii) the General Nursing of Scotland or (iii) Nursing Council of Northern Ireland.

(c) A certificate of the Central Mid-wives Board, London.

(B) If trained in India,

(a) A certificate of at least 3 year's training in a General Hospital of over 100 beds approved by the Madras Nurses and Mid-wives Council and a certificate of having passed the examination held at the end of the said course of training.

(b) A certificate of registration in section I-A or I-B or I-D of the Registrar of Nurses under the Madras Nurses and Midwives Act, 1926.

(c) A certificate of registration in section I-A of the Registrar of Midwives under the Madras Nurses and Midwives Act, 1926.

(d) A certificate of at least one Year's training in a recognised Public Health Nursing Institution in India and a certificate of having passed the Examination held at the end of the said course of training.

(e) A certificate of at least one Year's training in a recognised Health Visitor's School in India and a certificate of having passed the examination held at the end of the said course of training, and at least 3 years experience of Health Visiting in the field.

6. Age: A candidate shall not be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment unless she has completed the age of 21 years on the 1st day of July of the year in which selection for appointment is made and has not completed the age of 30 years on that date.

7. Pay: There shall be paid to the holder of the post of pay calculated in the scale of Rs. 165-10-2-175-15/2-205 per mensem.

NOTIFICATION II

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules relating to the temporary post of Technician Nutrition in the Public Health Department.

RULES
TECHNICIAN (NUTRITION)

1. The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holder of the temporary post of Technicians (Nutrition) in the Public Health Department, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.
2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate category of the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the post shall be --
 - (a) by promotion from Laboratory Attendants or Laboratory Assistants attached to the Office of the Director of Public Health, Madras or.
 - (b) by direct recruitment if no suitable candidate is available for appointment by promotion.
4. Appointing authority: The appointing authority shall be the Director of Public Health, Madras.
5. Qualifications: No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment unless--
 - I. he has not completed the age (of 26 years);
 - II. he has completed the course of study prescribed for the S.S.L.C. Course and appeared for the S.S.L.C. examination;
 - III. he has a good physique; good vision and capacity for outdoor work.
6. No persons shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possesses a certificate of training as Laboratory Technician conducted by the Director of Medical Services, Madras.
7. There shall be paid to the holder of the post a pay calculated in the scale of Rs. 45-3-75 per month.

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NOTIFICATION III

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules relating to the temporary posts of Vaccinators in the Public Health Department.

RULES
VACCINATORS

1. The General and Special rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts of vaccinators in the Public Health Department, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:
2. Constitution: The posts shall constitute a separate category of the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the posts shall be by direct recruitment.
4. Appointing Authority: The appointing authority shall be the Health Officer Class I concerned.
5. Age: A candidate shall be eligible for appointment to the category if he has not completed the age of 25 years.
6. Qualification: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category unless he possesses the following qualifications:
 - (I) A Sanitary Inspector's Certificate granted by the Director of Public Health, Madras as Chairman of the Board of Examiners constituted in this behalf by the State Government
 - (II) Ability to read and write atleast one of the languages mentioned below:-
Tamil, ~~and~~ Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada, Hindi, and Urdu.
 - (III) Physical fitness of camp life.
7. Private practice: A person appointed to the category shall not engage himself in private practice.
8. Pay: There shall be paid to the holders of the posts a pay calculated in the scale of Rs.50-3-80 per month.

NOTIFICATION IV.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby make the following rules relating to the temporary post of Mechanic, Malaria Control Team, Nilambur

RULES

1. The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of Mechanic, Malaria Control Team, Nilambur, subject to the following modifications:
2. Constitution. The post shall constitute a separate category of the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the said post shall be by direct recruitment.
4. Appointing Authority: The appointing authority shall be the Health Officer, Class I in charge of the scheme concerned.
5. Qualifications: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless.
 - (I) he has not attained the age of thirty years and
 - (II) he possess--
 - (a) Certificate for having undergone two years training in Automobile Engineering in a recognised Institute of Technology and
 - (b) a certificate as having undergone one year apprenticeship in Automobile Repairs in a Standard Firm.
6. There shall be paid to the holder/ of the post a pay calculated in the scale of Rs.80-2-100 per mensem.

NOTIFICATION V.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules relating to the temporary post of Motor Drivers in the Public Health Department.

RULES- MOTOR DRIVERS

1. The General and Special rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary posts of motor drivers employed in the Public Health Department, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.
2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate category of the said service.
3. Appointment: Appointment to the category shall be by direct recruitment.

4. Appointing authority: The appointing authority shall be the District Health Officer, the Regional Malariaologist, the Regional Nutrition Health Officer or the Health Officer Class I concerned.

5. Qualifications: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the category unless (i) he has completed the age of 21 years.

(ii) he is in possession of a current driving licence entitling him to drive a heavy as well as a light vehicle, and (iii) he is physically fit.

6. Probation: Every person appointed to the category shall from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a period of six months.

7. Termination of Services. The services of any person appointed to the category, who has put in a service of six months or more will be liable to be terminated in a month's notice. The holder of the post on his part shall also give a month's notice if he wishes to relinquish his post. In the case of persons with a service of less than six months, notice will be given for such period as may be practicable. Where it is not practicable to give the prescribed notice in the case of persons with a service of six months or more, the person concerned will be given the pay for the period by which the notice actually given falls short of thirty days.

8. Pay: There shall be paid to the holders of the said posts a pay calculated in the scale of Rs.35-1-45 in the case of drivers of light vehicles, and in the scale of Rs.40-1-50 in the case of drivers of heavy vehicles.

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
