In exercise of the powers conferred by the provise to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Madras hereby makes the following rules.

The rule hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 27th March 1957.

## RULES

The General and Special Rules applicable to the holders of permanent posts in the Madras Public Health Subordinate Service, shall apply to the holders of the Temporary posts of Mass Interviewers, Research cum Action Project, Poonamalles, sanctioned in G.O.Ms.No.1022, Health, dated 27.3.1957 subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:-

- 2. Constitution: The posts shall constitute a distinct category in the said service.
- 3. Appointment: Appointment to the posts shall be made by direct recruitment.
- 4. Appointing authority: The appointing authority to the posts shall be the Administrative Officer, Research cum Action Project, Poonamalles.
- 5.Age: No person shall be eligible for appointment to the posts unless he has completed the age of 21 years and will not complete the age of 30 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
  - 6. Qualifications: No persons shall be eligible for appointment to the posts unless he possess a degree of B.A., or B.Sc., in (Social and Cultural) Anthropology or Sociology of Economics or Home Science or Social Work of a University or Institution recognised by the University Grant Commission for purposes of its grants.
  - 7. Pay:- There shall be paid to the holders of the posts a monthly fixed pay of Rs. 200/- plus Rs. 50/- as Travelling Allowance per mensem.
