ORDER:

In the Government Orders first and second read above, 6 posts of Laboratory Technician Grade I have been sanctioned to District Surveillance Units at Thiruvallur, Vellore, Thiruvannamalai, Nagapattinam, Ramanathapuram and Arbovirus Antigen Production Laboratory at Institute of Vector Control and Zoonoses, Hosur. The posts are newly created and which are not in existence in the Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

The following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers, conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India; the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules.

The rules hereby made shall come into force on the 6.6.2002 .

RULES

The General and the Special rules applicable to the holders of the permanent post under Class II in the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service shall apply to the holder of the temporary post of Laboratory Technician Grade I, sanctioned from time to time to the District Surveillance Units or Arbovirus Antigen Production Laboratory, Institute of Vector and Zoonoses, Hosur, or other offices of the Public Health and Preventive Medicine Department, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:

2. Constitution- The post shall constitute a separate category under Class II of the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service.

3. Appointment- Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:-

- (i) by Promotion from the post of Technician (Filaria) or Laboratory Assistants under National Malaria Eradication Programme (or) National Filaria Control Programme; or
- (ii) by direct recruitment.

4. Appointing Authority- The appointing authority for the post shall be the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

5. Qualifications-

- (a) Age- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment if he has completed or will complete 30 years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
- (b) Other Qualification- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the method of appointment specified in column (1) of one Table below unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entry in column (2) thereof-

THE TABLE

Method of appointment	Qualification
1. By promotion	(i) Must have served for a period of not less than five years as Technician (Filaria); or (ii) Must have served for a period of not less than ten years as Laboratory Assistant.
2. By direct recruitment	Must have passed B.Sc., Degree with Zoology or equivalent.

Training - A candidate selected by direct recruitment shall undergo a pre-service training for a period of six months and obtain a certificate issued by Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

Reservation of appointment-The rule relating to reservation of appointments (General rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the post by direct recruitment.

Probation- Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within continuous period of three years.

Pay- There shall be paid to the holder of post a monthly pay calculated in the scale of pay Rs. 4500-125-7000.
