ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government emphasize the need for utmost economy in expenditure on Motor Vehicles. In the Government order eleventh read above continuance of the fuel ceiling scheme for the year 2003-2004 for the departmental vehicles was ordered and it was also indicated therein that the ceiling for consumption of fuel has to be observed strictly curtailing unnecessary trips. In the G.O.26th read above, the Government have fixed the fuel ceiling for Departments of Secretariat / Head of Departments concerned for the year 2016-2017 as was fixed in the G.O.25th read above. In the Government letters 27th cited above, the Government have issued authorization to admit the fuel claim bills upto December 2017 as per the fuel ceiling fixed for 2016-17.

- 2. Since most of the Departments are not furnishing the details of vehicles in time, Government is bound to issue orders retaining the previous year particulars every year in a routine manner. This system is in vogue and does not serve the purpose as per expectations. Further it is observed that as fuel allotment per vehicle is separately administered through a separate Government order and the budget provision for the Department concerned is fixed based on this G.O., and also the number of functional vehicles through discussion in Decentralized Budget meeting, now the Government have decided to discontinue the practice of issuing the order for fixation of annual ceiling on fuel consumption for department wise.
- After careful examination, the Government have decided to issue general orders indicating Petrol / Diesel ceiling limit per vehicle based on jurisdiction only.
- 4. Accordingly Government issue a general standing order indicating Petrol / Diesel ceiling limit per vehicle based on the Jurisdiction only as per the norms prescribed in the Annexure I & II to this order instead of issuing individual department wise fuel allotment.
 - 5. The Government also direct to follow the conditions indicated as below:-
 - i. The Departments of Secretariat / Head of the Departments are requested to use the Motor Vehicles, which are sanctioned by the Government in accordance with the fuel norms indicated in Annexure I & II to this order.
 - ii. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned are requested to ensure that fuel bills are settled based on the sanctioned G.O.,/ fuel ceiling norms fixed for the vehicles and also fuel bills for vehicles which are not covered by sanction should not be honoured.
 - iii. The Departments of Secretariat / Head of the Departments are requested to send the details of total sanctioned vehicles and vehicles which are in good road condition and in use to the PCB units in Finance Dept while sending the budget proposal for fixing the budget estimates as per the fuel norms indicated above.

- iv. The Departments of Secretariat / Head of Departments concerned are informed that no ratification for excess fuel consumption be entertained over the said standing norms in the Annexure I & II to this order.
- v: The cost of fuel consumed in excess of the operational ceiling fixed shall be recovered from the vehicle using officers concerned, if any. This should be enforced strictly. It may also be ensured that the fuel allotted is used for the sanctioned vehicles only.
