ORDER:

Government have reviewed the need for continuing the ban on the creation of new posts in Government Departments and direct that the ban orders issued in the Government Order read above shall be continued for a further period from 27.8.1990 to 30.9.1991.

- i. Government reiterate that the ban will cover the creation of all posts under non-plan as also under plan.
- ii. Creation of a new post in relaxation of this ban should be exceptional and will first have to be approved by a Staff Committee headed by the Chief Secretary and ~~existing~~ consisting of the Secretary Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Secretary Finance, and the Secretary of the concerned administrative department. In processing such cases the Secretary of the administrative department shall at first indicate the possibility of redeployment on a zero base budgeting approach.
- iii. No post which has been kept vacant for a period of five months or more will be filled up without specific reference to Government in the concerned Administrative Department as well as Finance Department.
- iv. As the creation of new posts on a higher grade in lieu of existing lower grade post, involves additional expenditure to Government, the approval of the above Committee should be obtained for any upgradation of the existing post also.

In the Government order cited, orders have been issued
notaralia that no post which has been kept vacant for a period
of five months or more would be filled up without specific
reference to Government in the concerned Administrative Department
as well as Finance Department. As a measure of avoiding unnecessary
paper work and local transfer/ additional charge arrangements
Govt. have decided to withdraw the order referred to above of obtaining
Government's permission to fill up the posts kept vacant for five
months or more. Accordingly Government direct that no permission
need be obtained from Government for filling up ~~the~~ of the posts
kept vacant for a period of five months or more. This order comes
into effect from the date of issue of this letter. However, strict
review must be done in the concerned administrative Department
as well as in Finance Department. While sanctioning continuance of
posts kept vacant for more than five months in accordance with
the principles of zero base Budgeting.
