ORDER:

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendments (1) and (2) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st June 1988 and the amendment (3) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th July 1993.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Fundamental Rules, in rule 114, under the heading "Delegation under Rule 114", in the Table under clause (a),-

(1) in Column (3) against the entry "(i) Pay" for items (a), (b) and (c), the following items shall be substituted, namely:-

(a) For employees in receipt of basic pay above Rs. 2200/- } 12½% of basic pay  
or Rs. 300/- which-  
ever is more.

(b) For employees in receipt of basic pay above Rs. 1000/- upto Rs. 2200/- } 15% of basic pay  
or Rs. 200/-  
whichever is more.

(c) For employees in receipt of basic pay of and below Rs. 1000/- } 20% of basic pay";

(2) for the entry in column (3) against the entry "(ii) Deputation Allowance", the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

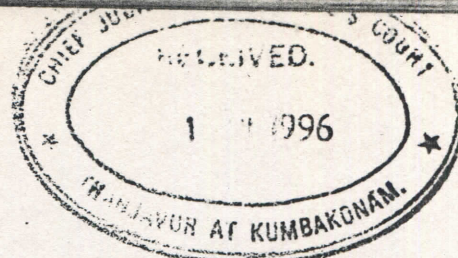
"In addition to grade pay, deputation allowance at 5% of basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs.250/- for transfer within the same station and 10% of basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs. 500/- in other case.

(3) after the entry "(vii) Pension Contribution" and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (1) to (4), the following entries shall respectively be added in Column (1) to (4), namely:-
