In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Madu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tundamental Rules. ..2/

2. The amendments (1) and (2) hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st June 1988 and the amendment (3) shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th July 1993.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Jundamental Rules, in rule 114, under the heading "Delegation under Rule 114", in the Table under clause (a),-

- (1) in Column (3) against the entry "(i) Pay" for items (a), (b) and (c), the following items shall be substituted, namely:-
 - (a) For employees in 12½% of basic pay receipt of basic pay or Rs. 300/- which-above Rs. 2200/- Yever is more.
 - (b) For employees in 15% of basic pay receipt of basic pay or Rs. 200/- above Rs. 1000/- upto whichever is more. Rs. 2200/-
 - (c) For employees in receipt of basic pay 20% of basic pay; of and below Rs. 1000/-
- (2) for the entry in column (3) against the entry "(ii) Deputation Allowance", the following entry shall be substituted, namely:-

"In addition to grade pay, deputation allowance at 5% of basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs.250/- for transfer within the same station and 10% of basic pay subject to a ceiling of Rs. 500/- in other case.

(3) after the entry "(vii) Pension Contribution" and the corresponding entries relating thereto in column (1) to (4), the following entries shall respectively be added in Column (1) to (4), namely:-
