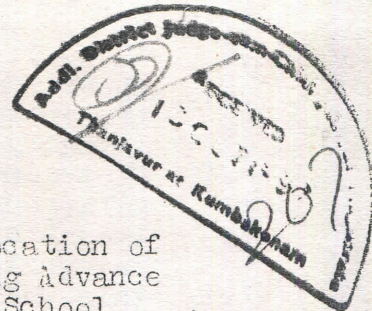

ORDER:

In the Government order read above, orders have been issued, permitting all the sanctioning authorities to sanction House Building Advance to Government Servant other than Panchayat Union School Teachers during the year 1996-97 as indicated therein:

2. A provision of Rs.41 crores has been made in the Budget Estimate 1997-98 for sanction of House Building Advance to Government Servants other than Panchayat Union School Teachers. The Government have examined the question of providing funds among the sanctioning authorities for sanction of House Building Advance to Government servants during 1997-98 with reference to the availability of funds. The Government have decided to allocate the total allotment made in the Budget Estimate 1997-98 to various districts in proportion to the number of pending applications.

3. The Government accordingly permit all the sanctioning authorities to sanction House Building Advance to the Government servants other than Panchayat Union School teachers during the year 1997-98, for the pending applications which are in complete shape. The sanction should be accorded as per strict seniority. The sanctioning authorities are requested to ensure that the rules and procedures laid down for the sanction of House Building Advance are strictly adhered to while according formal sanction/sanction for the release of advance/instalment of the House Building Advance.

4. The amount allocated to each sanctioning authority for the sanction of House Building Advance for pending application in all categories except Ready Built House (Tamil Nadu Housing Board) and spill over cases is detailed in the Annexure I. The amount allocated to the ready Built House category (Tamil Nadu Housing Board) is shown in Annexure II.

5. The sanctioning authorities are requested to apportion the total amount allocated to their districts in proportion to the number of applications pending in each category of loan viz., Loan for Ready Built House (Private), Plot-cum-construction, construction, Spill over items, Enlargement and Improvement etc., while apportioning the amount higher priority should be given in respect of categories "Construction" and "Plot-cum-construction" since this will increase the over all housing stock considerably.

6. The sanctioning authorities viz., the District Collectors should ensure that the total expenditure on account of House Building Advance sanctioned by them does not exceed the amount allocated to them. They should also mention specifically in their proceedings, relating the advance regarding the availability of funds out of the amount allocated in their districts over the expenditure as ordered in this Government order.

7. The expenditure sanctioned by the respective sanctioning authorities shall be debited to "7610 00 Loans to Government servants etc., -201 House Building Advances - Schemes in the Ninth Five Year Plan - II State Plan - JA. Loans to Government Servants for construction of houses 02 Advances to other Government Servants (D.P. Code No.7610 00 201 JA 0209)

8. The Treasury Officers/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to ensure that the expenditure on account of the drawals under House Building Advance in respect of the sanction made by the District Collectors does not exceed the amount allocated to the Collectors in the respective districts. The District Collectors are requested to send quarterly report so as to enable the Government to review the progress.

9. All Collectors are requested to send the statement of departmental figures of expenditure under House Building Advance duly reconciled with the Treasury figures so as to reach the Government by 20th of each month positively.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 46542/97-1, Fin. (HUD & MAWS) Dt. 19.6.97.
