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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund has been constituted to provide financial assistance to Government employees where the employees are struck by major ailments. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued extending the scheme to family members. In G.O.Ms.No.846, Finance (salaries), dated 14.12.93, the heads of departments were delegated with powers to sanction assistance under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme to the employees under their control and a list of accredited institutions wherein Government employees may be permitted to undertake specialised surgeries/treatment has been furnished. A few more specialised surgeries/treatment that are eligible for assistance under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund were specified in the Government Order third read above. Further list of accredited institutions was included in the Government Order fourth read above.

2. Government employees and their family members are undergoing various kinds of eye operations/treatment for which facilities are not available in Government hospitals. Proper care and maintenance of eyes are very essential for Government employees for discharge of their duties.

3. Considering the above factors, it has been decided to provide financial assistance to Government employees and their family member under the Tamil Nadu Government employees and their family members under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund for undergoing the following specialised surgeries/advanced surgeries, treatment in Ophthalmology (eye):-

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1. Any cataract Surgery with or without I.O.L. (Intra-Ocular Lens).
2. Surgery for detachment of RETINA.
3. Vitrectomy
4. Kevatoplasty (Corneal Grafting)
5. Lasor treatment-Excimer-laser, Argon Laser, Photo-Coagulation.
6. Glaucoma Surgery and laser treatment.
7. Linear Acclerator therapy (for Senile Macular degeneration, tumours etc).

4. Government also direct that assistance from the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund may be availed for treatment/surgery in Ophthalmology in respect of the items indicated in para-3 above, in the following institutions:-

1. Willington Nursing Home, Haddows Road, Nungambakkon, Madras.
2. Malar Hospital, Adayar, Madras.
3. Prens Eye Clinic, 5, Bazaar Road, Saidapet, Madras.
4. Kumaran Hospital, Poonamallee High Road, Madras.
5. Apollo Cancer Institute, Anna Salai, Madras.
6. Sankara Nethrayaya, College Road, Madras.
7. Vijaya Hospital (TERF), Madras.
8. MN Eye Hospital, Tondiarpet, Madras.
9. Tamil Nadu Hospital, 439 Cheran Nagar, Perumbakkam, Madras.
10. Arvind Eye Hospital, Madurai.
11. Joseph's Eye Hospital, Tiruchirappalli.
12. K.G. Hospital, Coimbatore.
13. T.M.S. Eye Hospital, Salem.

5. For the expeditious disposal of claims of the employees for financial assistance from Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund towards undergoing specialised treatment in Ophthalmology, Government direct that the heads of departments shall consult the Superintendent, Institute of Ophthalmology, Government Ophthalmic Hospital, Egmore in respect of employees in Madras City and that in respect of employees in districts, should consult the District Medical Officers, before forwarding the applications for sanction of assistance from the fund by the heads of departments.
