

Medical Aid - Special Surgery/Treatment - Assistance to Pensioners - Constitution of Tamil Nadu Government Pensioner's Health Fund - Further Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued implementing the Tamil Nadu Government Tensioners' Health Fund Scheme in respect of State Government Pensioners including Teacher Pensioners with effect from 1.7.1995. In the Government order fourth read above, orders have been issued extending the Tamil Nadu Government Tensioner's Health Fund Scheme in respect of the pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu Cadre with effect from 1.4.1997 According to this scheme, each pensioner shall subscribe a sum of Rs.5/- per annum to this Dund. The Government will match this with a contribution of Rs.5/- per annum per pensioner. An assistance of Rs.50,000/- or 75% of the actual cost of treatment whichever is less is given to pensioners for undergoing certain special surgeries/treatment in certain accredited Institutions in Tamil Wadu.

- 2. The above scheme was started as a contributory pilot schene of assistance and its continuance is subject to the Mund being financially self sustaining. With the enlargement of the list of accredited institutions and the list of special surgeries/treatment, there has been an im reasing trend in the preserence of claims. This has resulted in huge out flow of funds. The Government have therefore decided to enhance the existing contribution and also confine release of assistance only to cases falling under Government guidelines. Accordingly the following orders are passed.
 - i. Financial assistance will be sanctioned only for the specified surgeries/treatment undergone at the accredited hospitals listed out in G.O. Ms. No. 562, Finance (Pension) dated 11.7.1995 and G.O.Ms.No.818, Finance (Salaries) dated 20.10.1995 and notified by the Government from time to time.
