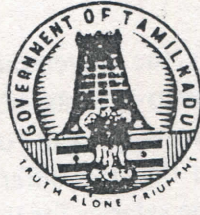

**Medical Assistance - Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme, 1991 - Annual subscription - Enhanced - Orders - Issued.**

**ORDER :**

The Government in their Order first read above had constituted the "Government Employees Health Fund" to provide a measure of relief to Government employees when they suffer from major ailments. The Government, had also fixed an annual subscription of Rs.5/- from each employee, recoverable from the salary payable for the month of June every year. When the scheme was introduced in 1992, the maximum quantum of financial assistance was Rs.25,000/- and this was enhanced to Rs.50,000/- in March 1993 and to Rs.1,00,000/- in March 1995; but the Government have not enhanced the subscription payable by the employees.

2. In the recent past, the scheme has been liberalised by extending financial assistance to many surgeries / treatment and also by enlarging the list of accredited institutions resulting in a large number of claims seeking financial assistance from this fund. In view of this, there is a steep increase in disbursement. The Government have reviewed the situation with reference to the fund position and the need for extending financial assistance to more number of cases and decided to enhance the annual subscription from Rs.5/- to Rs.25/- recoverable from each employee towards Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme.

3. Accordingly, the Government direct that a sum of Rs.25/- per annum (Rupees twenty five only) be recovered as subscription from each employee towards the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme from the year 1997-98 onwards. The Government also direct that the difference in subscription for the current year 1997-98 be recovered from the salaries for the month of August 1997.
