MEDICAL ASSISTANCE - Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme 1991 - Enhancement of subscription - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

The Government in their Order first read above had constituted the "Government Employees Health Fund" to provide a measure of relief to Government employees when they are struck by major ailments. The Government had fixed an annual subscription of Rs.5/- from each employee recoverable from the salary payable for the month of June every year.

2. When the scheme was introduced in 1992, the maximum quantum of financial assistance was Rs.25,000/- This was enhanced to Rs.50,000/- in March 1993, and further enhanced to Rs.1 lakh in March 1995. In view of steep increase in disbursement of financial assistance, the Government had enhanced the annual subscription at Rs.25/- from the financial year 1997-98.

3. Since the scheme has been liberalised by extending financial assistance to many more surgeries/treatment and also by enlarging the list of accredited institutions, a large number of claims have been received from Government employees seeking financial assistance from this fund.

4. The Government have reviewed the situation with reference to the fund position and the need for extending the financial assistance to all the eligible cases received. The Government have, therefore, decided to enhance the subscription, recoverable from each employee towards Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme.

5. Accordingly, the Government direct that a sum of Rs.10/- (Rupees ten only) per month be recovered as subscription from each employee towards Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme 1991.

6. The order shall also apply to the teaching and non-teaching staff working in all the aided educational institutions. There shall be no change in the other existing rules and conditions.

7. The recovery shall take effect from the salary payable for the month of December 1998.
