Medical Aid - Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme - Enhancement of Pensioners' contribution - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Orders first to third read above, orders have been issued implementing the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme in respect of the State Government pensioners including teacher pensioners and the pensioners of All India Services belonging to the Tamil Nadu cadre. According to this scheme, each pensioner will contribute a sum of Rs.5/- per annum to the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund which was enhanced to Rs.10/- per annum in the Government Order fifth read above from the year 1997 - 98. The Government have also contributed a sum of Rs.8 lakhs (Rupees eight lakhs only) per annum towards the scheme. An assistance of Rs.50,000/- or 75% of the actual cost of treatment whichever is less is being given to the pensioner for undergoing certain specialised surgeries / treatment in certain accredited institutions in Tamil Nadu.

2. The Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund scheme was started as a contributory pilot scheme of assistance under the condition that its continuance would be subject to the Fund being financially self-sustaining. In the Government Order sixth read above, orders have been issued enhancing the existing contribution payable by the pensioners from Rs.10/- per annum to Rs.5/- per month towards the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund as the fund position was not sufficient to meet the expenditure.

3. The Director of Pension in his letter seventh read above has stated that the average requirement of funds per month to meet the expenditure is about Rs. 28 lakhs but the receipt from the pensioners towards the fund will be about Rs.14 lakhs per month and this has resulted in a position where the receipt of funds are not sufficient to meet the needs of all eligible claims. He has therefore requested the Government to enhance the existing pensioners' contribution from Rs.5/- per month to Rs.10/- per month towards the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund. The Government have examined the proposal carefully and in order to continue the scheme on self financing basis, the Government have decided to enhance the existing contribution as proposed by the Director of Pension. Accordingly the Government direct that the contribution recovered from the pensioners towards the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund be increased from Rs.5/- per month to Rs.10/-per month from 1.10.2001 i.e. the pension payable for the month of October, 2001.
