Sub: Deputation - Deputation of Government  
servants for higher studies - Revised  
procedure - Instructed - Regarding.

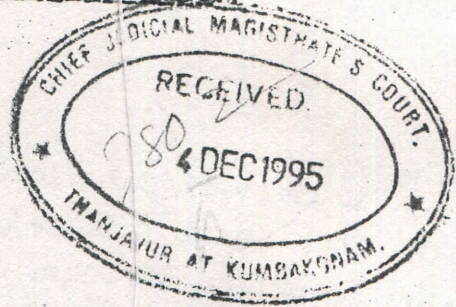
Of late, it has become a practice among certain  
Government departments to sponsoring employees for higher  
studies viz. P.G. degrees/diploma fully at the cost of  
Government expenditure.

2. In view of the difficult financial position, it  
is decided not to allow this unhealthy practice to con-  
tinue. Accordingly, Heads of Departments are informed that  
if they require a qualified hand in a particular specialised  
subject, it is advisable for them to recruit the required  
qualified persons in that field from the open competition  
subject to the condition that the overall number of existing  
posts should not exceed. On the other hand, they are expected  
not to come up with proposals for higher studies seeking  
full Government backed support. If an employee wants to  
acquire P.G. degree/diploma, he should go on study leave at  
his own costs.

3. Therefore all Heads of Departments are requested  
strictly not to entertain any such proposals in future. The  
Administrative departments of Secretariat are also requested  
that if any such proposal are received from the Heads of  
Departments in future, they can reject the proposals themselves  
without referring them to Finance Department.
