payment of gratuity / Leave salary

Certain doubts have been raised as to how interest
for the belated payment of gratuity amount authorised by
Accountant General has to be calculated in the light of
the clarification issued in the reference second cited and
also regarding the procedure to be followed to disburse
the balance gratuity in the case of retired Government
servants who dies in the intervening period upto March, 2003.

2. I am directed to clarify that 60% of the difference
in gratuity / leave salary to be paid after five years (i.e. 2003-
04), consequent on the revised scales of pay shall be allowed
interest at the rate applicable to the G.P.F. account of the
living employees. As such the pension sanctioning authorities
are authorised to disburse the said amount along with interest
after five years, i.e., in the year 2003-2004. However,
in the case of employees who happen to expire in the intervening
period prior to 1.4.2003, the entire amount of arrears inclusive
difference in gratuity, leave salary, etc., along with interest
upto that date may be drawn and paid in cash to the spouse/legal
heirs as the case may be.
