Interim Relief - Grant of another instalment of Interim Relief to the State Government pensioners / family pensioners including pensioners/ family pensioners of local bodies and aided educational Institutions - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued sanctioning the payment of Interim Relief to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners including the pensioners/family pensioners of Local Bodies and Aided Educational Institutions at the flat rate of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty only) per mensem and in addition, 10% of the basic pension/family pension subject to a minimum of Rs.50/- (Rupees fifty only) per emsem with effect from 1.10.1995. In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued that the Interim Relief sanctioned in the Government Order first read above be given retrospective effect from 1.4.1995. In the Government Order third read above, orders have been issued sanctioning the payment of Interim Relief at the flat rate of Rs.50/- per mensem and in addition 10% of the ex-gratia amount subject to a minimum of Rs.50/- per mensem with effect from 1.4.1995 to the widows/ widowers and the dependent children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund/Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries and the employees of the former District Board who had retired from service or died while in service prior to 1.1.1986 and who are in receipt of the ex-gratia amount of Rs.150/- per mensem.

2. In the Office Memorandum fourth read above, the Government of India have sanctioned another instalment of Interim Relief with effect from 1.4.1996 at the rate of

10% of the basic pension/family pension subject to a minimum of Rs. 100 per mensem to their pensioners/family pensioners and similar increase to the widows and dependent children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund beneficiaries who had retired from service or who had died while in service prior to 1.1.1986 and who are in receipt of exgratia amount with effect from 1.4.1996.

- 3. Following the orders of the Government of India, the Government have decided to grant another instalment of Interim Relief to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners at the same rates as granted by the Government of India. They accordingly sanction another instalment of Interim Relief at the rate of 10% of the basic pension/family pension subject to a minimum of Rs 100 per mensem to the State Government pensioners including the pensionerrs/ family pensioners of Local Bodies and Aided Educational Institutions with effect from 1.4.1996. They also sanction another instalment of Interim Relief at the rate of 10% of the ex-gratia amount subject to a minimum of Rs. 100/- per mensem with effect from 1.4.1996 to the widows/widowers and the dependent children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund/Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries and the employees of the former District Board who had retired from service or died while in service prior to 1.1.1986 and who are in receipt of ex-gratia amount of Rs. 150/- per mensem.
- 4. The Government also direct that the Interim Relief now sanctioned would be fully adjusted against and merged in the pensionary benefits that may become admissible in the event of general revision.
- 5. If a pensioner/family pensioner is re-employed or employed under the Central or State Government or a Corporation/Company/Body/Bank under them in India or abroad including permanent absorption in such Corporation/Company/Body/Bank, he/she shall not be eligible to draw Interim Relief on pension/family pension during the period of such re-employment.
- 6. The Interim Relief shall be shown as a separate element. No Dearness Allowance on the Interim Relief will be admissible. Interim Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 7. In the case of persons in respect of more than one pension, the Interim Relief shall be calculated on the total of all pensions taken together.
- 8. In respect of pensioners/family pensioners for whom expenditure is met from the State funds the expenditure shall be debited under the sub-detailed head "2.Interim Relief" under the detailed head "27.Pensions" under relevant minor sub-head under the major head "2071.Pension and other Retirement Benefits". In respect of the pensioners/family pensioners of local bodies for whom expenditure is met from the fund maintained by the Director of Local Fund Audit or Municipal Fund, as the case may be, the expenditure shall be met from the respective funds referred to above.
