Upgradation of 287 posts of Assistants ^{into}
that of Superintendents.

I am directed to invite your attention to the reference cited and to state that 188 posts of Assistants were upgraded as Superintendents in G.O.Ms.No.662, dt. 21-5-93. At that stage ~~287~~ posts of Superintendents were already in existence. Hence out of 283 posts, now only 100 posts have been allotted to the Primary Health Centres. The number of Superintendent posts cannot be increased. I am therefore directed to state that out of 283 posts of Superintendents, more number of posts can be allotted to the block Primary Health Centres on same norm basis and the smaller Primary Health Centres managed by Assistant level clerical staff.
