In T.A.No.566 of 1989, the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal ordered that Rule 49 as it stands today will not debar the applicant, who entered into Government service prior to the introduction of the rule namely 24-1-61 from making application for alteration of Date of Birth. Accordingly in the reference first cited it was clarified that the application to be received for alteration of date of birth from members who were appointed prior to the introduction of this rule, that is prior to 24-1-61 may be entertained and examined on marits following the procedure laid down in General Rule 49. Later, in the reference second cited, considering the multiplicity of applications received for alteration of date of birth at the fag end of service, at the time of retirement, the General Rule 49 was amended, by introducing a proviso under rule 49(c) prescribing a time limit of one year before the date of his retirement for making such application for the person who entered into service prior to 24-1-1951.

Now, the Supreme Court of India, in the reference third cited observed that rule 49 is to be harmoniously interpreted. The application for correction of date of birth of an in-service employee should be made within 5 years from the date when the is made after expiry of 5 years, the Government employee losses his right to make the application.

Services Rules Part II will be applicable irrespective of the date of entry into service, and also observed that necessary amendment to the rules in line with the decision of the Supreme Court may be issued.

The Government considered the matter in detail and decided to amend General Rule 49 accordingly.

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the General Rules in Part II of the Tamil Nodu State and Subordinate Services Rules (Volume I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1987/.

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 3rd August 1994.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules, in rule 49, in sub-rule (c), the proviso shall be omitted.
