Sub: Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal - Sanction of fees to Law Officers, Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal - Mode of payment - Instructions -Isaued.

Ref: Government Letter No.57966/SAT/33-7, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (SAT), dated 29.7.94.

I am directed to state that in the Government Laetter wited instructions were issued that the fees due to the Law Officers, he claimed by the Secretaries to Government and Meads of Departments from the Pay and Accounts Officer or Treasury by presenting bills and then make payment to the Law Officers of the Tribunal by way of Demand Draft.

- 2. The Menior Standing Counsel, Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal has now stated that the above directions causes emprmous delay in the payment of legal fees to the Government Advocates in the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal and the Law Officers pare not able to get their fees in time. He has therefore requested the Government to cancel the instructions issued in the Government letter cited and to permit the Departments to issue proreedings directing the Law Officers of Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal to withdraw the amount through the converned Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasury.
- 3. The Government have accepted the proposal of Semior ttanding Counsel and accordingly cancel the instructions issued in the Government letter cited. The fees claimed by the Law Officers, shall be sanctioned by the Secretaries to Government and Heads of Departments and the Law Officers of Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal themselves will be authorized to present and draw the amount through the concerned ay and Accounts Office/ reasury. The above instructions may be followed scruplously.
