ORDER:

As per Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Services (Section 26 in Volume -III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual 1970) the method of recruitment for the post of Driver is as follows:-

" 1. Promotion from the post of Cleaner's OR

2. Recruitment by transfer from among the members of the Tamil Nadu Basic Service in the Office of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Regional Assistant Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Health Unit District, Chief Water Analyst, Filaria Officer and other Mofussil Offices under the control of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine; OR

3. Direct recruitment, if no suitable candidate is available by the above methods."

The following qualifications have been prescribed for appointment to the post of Driver in the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service:-

- i) Must possess a current licence issued by a competent licensing authority of the State Government to drive heavy motor vehicles.

ii) Must possess experience in driving motor vehicle for a period of not less than two years; and

iii) Must have passed III form or VIII Standard in a recognised School or must possess the Indian Army Third Class English Certificate.

2. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that certain cleaners and the Office Assistants working in the Office of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine are having necessary education qualification and heavy vehicle driving licence but they do not have two years driving experience, since they have acquired the driving licence after joining Government service and that they could not acquire the experience of driving heavy vehicle earlier and therefore, suggested that the Cleaners and Office Assistants of the Office of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine may be exempted from acquiring two years experience of driving heavy vehicles and the following amendment may be issued to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service:-

"The Departmental candidates are exempted from acquiring two years experience of driving heavy vehicles for appointment as drivers in the Tamil Nadu Public Health Subordinate Service."

3. The Director, State Health Transport Department when consulted has stated that the Office Assistants/Cleaners etc. who are possessing Driving Licence might have got previous experience in driving and that based on their driving licence, they can be given training for about 45 days to get sufficient experience in driving. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also stated that there are 23 Office Assistants etc. in the Department, who are otherwise qualified for the post of Driver, except the experience required and that there will no extra expenditure involved in giving 45 days training, except Travelling Allowance and Daily Allowance. Out of 45 days, they may have to go with vehicle on camp for 20 days in a month and for the remaining 25 days they can be trained locally. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has therefore requested the Government to issue orders to give training to Office Assistants/Cleaners etc. for 45 days.

4. The Government after careful examination direct that the Office Assistants/Cleaners working under the control of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine who are possessing Driving Licence be given training for about 45 days to get sufficient experience in driving.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is also requested to send draft amendment to the special Rules in consultation with the Director, State Health Transport Organisation.
