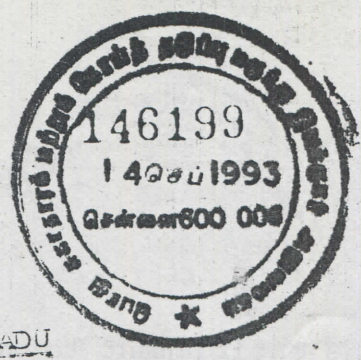

ORDER:

The Fifth Tamil Nadu Pay Commission has recommended that these Officers upto the level of Additional Secretaries to Government who are at present eligible to have two office Assistants for residence may be permitted to choose either one Office Assistant at their residence without surrender facility for another Office Assistant or to receive lumpsum amount of Rs.500/- per month to employ a person of their choice or daily wages. The Pay Commission has also recommended that the existing rate of cash allowance of Rs.150/- per month may be enhanced to Rs.250/- per month.

2) The Government have carefully examined the recommendations of the Pay Commission on this issue in detail. The system of having full time residential office assistants is to be gradually phased out. It has therefore been decided to restrict the eligibility in future and also encourage the surrender of office assistants in favour of cash reimbursement of engagement of services of an attendant at home. The Government therefore pass the following orders..

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a) The entitlement to residential Office Assistants to various categories of officers shall be as follows.

Designation of Officers (1)	No. of Residential Office Assistants entitled (2)
i) Chief Secretary grade officers	2
ii) Secretaries and Special Secretaries	2
iii) Additional Secretaries, Joint Secretaries, Heads of Departments, Collectors, District Judges, Superintendents of Police and Superintending Engineers	2 (One should be compulsorily surrendered in lieu of cash Allowance)
iv) Deputy Secretaries District Revenue Officers, under Secretaries, Executive Engineer and others in the pay range of Rs.3000/- 4500 and who are presently entitled for a residential Office Assistant.	1 (to be compulsorily surrendered in lieu of cash allowance for new incumbents to these posts after 1.3.93).
v) All others who are below the pay scale of Rs.3000-4500 but are entitled for a Residential Office Assistant by a Specific order.	1 (to be compulsorily surrendered in lieu of cash allowance. This facility to this category will be given only to the existing incumbent as on 1.3.93. and once he vacates the post, his successor will not be entitled to this facility. It will not be available to these appointed or promoted after 1.3.93.)

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b) The Officers who are entitled to two residential Office Assistants under items (i) and (ii) in (a) above can surrender both the Office Assistants if they so desire. In respect of Officers mentioned in Item (iii) in the statement in para 2 (a) above, they should surrender one Office Assistant compulsorily and the other at their option. In respect of categories under (iv) and (v) in Para (a) above the surrender of the office assistant is compulsory in respect of new incumbents after 1.3.93.

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c) The cash allowance in lieu of surrendering one Office Assistant is increased from the present rate of Rs.150/- per month to Rs.250/- per month with effect from 1.3.93. If both the residential Office Assistants are surrendered by officers who are entitled to have two residential Office Assistants, they shall be eligible for a cash allowance of Rs.500/- per month.

d) The revised rates shall take effect from 1.3.93.

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3. As regards the entitlements to Office Assistants in the office rooms of the Officers concerned, the orders issued already in G.O.Ms.No.668, Finance, Dated 24.8.1992 will be applicable.

4. All Heads of departments are requested to communicate these orders to all subordinate officers under their control.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, vide its U.O.No. 543/FS/93-1 Dated 5.2.93.
