Entitlement of Office Assistant at the residence
of the Officers during the period of deputation
Clarification - Issued.

According to the orders issued in G.O.first cited,
Officers who have surrendered their residential Office
Assistant are not eligible for the Cash Allowance during
the period spent on leave, transit availed on transfer,
deputation, training, suspension or any periods during
which he becomes ineligible for the services of an Office
Assistant. A doubt has been raised as to whether Officers
sent on deputation or training abroad for a period less than
one year and who are utilising the services of residential
Office Assistant may be allowed to continue the services of
Office Assistant during the period of deputation.

2. Iam directed to clarify that Officers sent on depu-
tation on account of Government sponsored further studies,
Fellowship or training abroad, for a period less than one
year and who have utilised the services of residential
Office Assistant shall be allowed to continue the services
of residential Office Assistant during the period of such
deputations. Other officers who have surrendered the
residential Office Assistant and availed the cash allowance
shall be entitled for cash allowance during the period of
deputation mentioned above.
