In such cases, the pay shall be fixed notionally on the last date of their service or on the date of the retirement on superannuation, as the case may be, at the stage at which they would have drawn, had they been promoted or appointed to the higher post along with their juniors for the purpose of pension and other monetary terminal benefits."
