ORDER:

The following amendment is issued to Fundamental Rules :-

2. The amendment hereby made shall come into force on and from 30.10.2000.

AMENDMENT

In the said Fundamental Rules, under Rule 27, in ruling (17), the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

"Provided that in case of Government Servants whose names were deferred for inclusion in the panel for promotion to higher post due to pendency of charges, but subsequently included in the same panel on exoneration of the charges after the date of their retirement on superannuation on appeal or review, their pay shall be fixed notionally on the date of their retirement on superannuation at the stage at

which they would have drawn, had they been promoted or appointed to the higher post along with their junior for the purpose of pension and other monetary terminal benefit.

Provided further that in the case of Government servants whose names were deferred for inclusion in the panel due to pendency of charges and have subsequently died while in service or after retirement from service, the charges shall automatically stand abate. In such cases, the pay shall be fixed notionally on the last date of their service or on the date of the retirement on superannuation, as the case may be, at the stage at which they would have drawn, had they been promoted or appointed to the higher post along with their juniors for the purpose of pension and other monetary terminal benefits."
