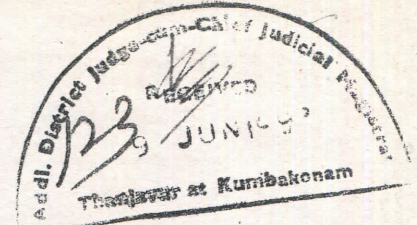

ORDER:

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions to Article 309, read with Article 313, of the Constitution of India, and of all other powers hereto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st July 1936.

AMENDMENT

In the said Fundamental Rules, in Appendix I, in Annexure III, in the Tamil Nadu Leave Rules, 1933, in rule 7, -

- (1) in sub-rule (i), -//(ii) after the words "other than earned leave" the words "and leave on private affairs" shall be inserted;
 - (ii) after the words "encashment of earned leave" the words "and leave on private affairs" shall be inserted;
 - (iii) after the words "pay slips for encashment of earned leave" the words "and leave on private affairs shall be inserted:
- (2) in sub-rule (ii)-//(i) after the expression "maximum of 240 days" the expression "and shall be eligible for cash equivalent of full leave salary including Dearness allowance and all other allowances for the entire period of leave at credit"; shall be added:
- (3) after sub-rule(ii) the following sub-rule shall be added, namely:-
 - "iii) The benefit of encashment of leave on private affairs on the date of retirement or on the date of termination of extension of service as the case may be shall be subject to 50 per cent of the leave on private affairs standing to the credit of the Government servant subject to a maximum of 90 days, with full leave salary including Dearness allowance and all other allowances."
- (4) In the Explanation, after the words "For the purpose of encashment of earned leave" the words "and leave on private affairs" shall be inserted.
