I am to invite your attention to the references cited
and to state that if junior employee who was in receipt of the
personal pay granted in the G.O. second cited with effect from
1.9.98 happens to draw more pay than his senior (who was
promoted to higher post prior to 1.9.98) consequent on his
promotion to higher post after 1.9.98, such anomalies can be
rectified by stepping up the pay of the seniors on par with
that of the junior, subject to the fulfilment of other
conditions prescribed under Fundamental Rules on the analogy
of the clarifications issued in the reference first cited.
