to grant 5% of basic pay as personal pay to all the employees
in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs. 905-1545 moving over to
the revised scale of pay of Rs. 1600-2660.

3. I am to state that eventhough the posts of Head Clerk
and Deputy Nazir District Munsif's Court, Record Keeper and

Translator District Court and Head Clerk of Sub-Court were upgraded to the level of Superintendents in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs.1600-2660 as ordered in the G.O. third cited, they have actually moved from Rs.780-1385 to Rs.1600-2660 with effect from 1.6.88 and hence they were not allowed 5% personal pay as per the G.O. first cited. These as per the conditions laid down in the G.O. fourth cited, these categories of employees are not eligible for 5% personal pay in the revised pay scales also.

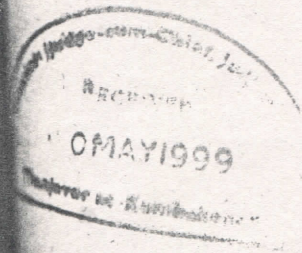
