ORDER:

1. The Tamil Nadu Health Inspector's Association has represented for fixation of pay Block Health Supervisors by counting the services rendered in the lower post of Selection Grade / Special Grade Health Inspector Grade I.

2. The scale of pay for the post of Health Inspector Grade-I and Block Health Supervisor are as follows:

It is seen from the above, table that the Selection Grade / Special Grade scale of pay of the post of Health Inspector Grade-I is identical / higher than the Ordinary Grade scale of pay of the promotional post viz Block Health Supervisor. Hence the services rendered in the post of Selection Grade / Special Grade Health Inspector Grade - I can be counted for awarding Selection Grade in the promotion post of Block Health Supervisor as per the orders issued in GO.(Ms)No.210 Personnel and Administrative Reforms (S) Department, dated 11-4-87 and Government Letter No.32/S/96-1 dated 26-9-97 and Government Letter(Ms). No.168/S/98, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 28-9-99.

3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that the Health Inspectors Grade-I (formerly Multi Purpose Health Supervisors) who were originally appointed by direct recruitment have requested the concession of awarding Selection Grade by counting the services rendered in the lower post. The above individuals i.e those who were appointed directly as Health Inspector Grade I, and subsequently promoted as Block Health Supervisors (first level promotion) have not availed the concession granted in Government Letter (Ms).No.168/S/98, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 28.9.99 so far. He has also stated that some individuals, those who were appointed as Health Inspector Grade I (formerly Basic Health Workers) are now being promoted as Block Health Supervisors. These Block Health Supervisors have already availed the benefit of counting their services rendered in the lower post of Health Inspector Grade II (formerly Basic Health Worker) for awarding Selection Grade in the promotional post of Health Inspector Grade-I as per G.O.(Ms).No. 308, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 16.9.2003.

4. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the request of the Tamil Nadu Health Inspector's Association and Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. In view of the position explained in para 2 above, the Government direct that the services rendered in the lower post of selection grade / special grade of the Health Inspector Grade I, who were originally appointed as Multi Purpose Health Supervisor by direct recruitment and subsequently re-designated as Health Inspector Grade-I and not availed the concession ordered in G.O.Ms.No.308, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 16.9.03 so far in their service period, be counted for the award of Selection Grade in the promotional post of Block Health Supervisor from 04-11-1983

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 76791/PC/2006, dated 2.1.2007.
