NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to  
Article 309 of the Constitution of India, The Governor of  
Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the special  
rules for Tamil Nadu Public Health subordinate service (Section 26  
in Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual) 1987.

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force with  
effect on and from the 29th day of February 1996.

AMENDMENTS

In the said special rules:-

- (1) in rule 2 in the Tabular column under sub rule (a)  
under the heading "Class I", in the entries in the  
second column, against the entry "30 Driver" in the  
first column thereof, for items 1 and 2, the following  
items shall be substituted, namely:-
  - "(1) Promotion from among the holders of the post of  
Van Cleaner; or
  - (2) recruitment by transfer from among the holders of  
the posts of Office Assistant and Cleaner in the  
Department of Public Health and Preventive Medicine  
and all other non-fussal officers under the control of  
the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine,  
in the Tamil Nadu Basic Service; or";

2. In rule 3, for sub-rule (2) the following sub rule shall be substituted, namely:

(2) the appointing authority for the post of Drivers shall be the Head of the Institution concerned, who shall be not below the rank of Health Officer in Medical, and the Personnel Officer, Office of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in head quarters";

(3) in the annexure, under the heading "Class I in the entries in column (2) against the entry "30 Drivers in column (1) thereof for item 2, the following item shall be substituted, namely:

(a) In the case of appointment by promotion or by recruitment by transfer, must have undergone 45 days training comprising 20 days in camp and 25 days local training by a senior Driver of the same office.

(b) In the case of direct recruitment must possess experience in driving motor vehicles for a period of not less than two years, and"
