In the G.O.second cited instructions have been issued for the reinstatement of all the 999 employees who have been dismissed from service based on the orders of the panel of three Judges.

2. In the reference letter third cited, the Special Council appointed by the Government as per the orders issued in the G.O first cited, has brought to the notice of the Government that the Applicant's who have filed cases before the Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal against the orders of the dismissal, have decided to pursue the cases pending before the Tribunal and are challenging the modified punishment imposed on them.



3. The special Counsel has intimated that these cases are posted for hearing on 2.3.2004 and advised to file a reply affidavit in all the cases. He has also requested to instruct the Departments to collect the papers for the preparation of reply affidavit.

4. All the appointing authorities are therefore requested to take suitable action immediately based on the views expressed by the Special Counsel referred to above.
