I am directed to state that in the references cited, the Covernment have issued detailed guidelines for conducting counselling for transfer and promotion to the personnel working in Health and Family Welfare Department According to these guidelines no transfer should be effected in between the counselling periods other than those required on administrative grounds based on allegations and charges which should be recorded in writing.

2. In spite of these instructions, proposal for mutual transfer has been received from certain Heads of Department in between the counselling periods. In this connection, I am directed to inform you that requests for mutual transfer should not be allowed in between the counselling periods and that such request should be considered as per regular counselling guidelines only during the counseling period. These instructions should be followed strictly.

2. Violation of these instructions will be viewed seriously by the Government.
