I invite kind attention of the Government to the references cited wherein
the following instructions have been issued for posting of newly recruited Medical
Officers.

" Medical Officers who are newly recruited should be posted only in the
Health Unit Districts where there are 10% and above of the total post of
Medical Officers are vacant"


Hence, I wish to submit the following the proposal for the kind
consideration and approval of Government:

In 15 Health Unit Districts, the vacancy of Medical Officers are above 20%
against the sanctioned strength. The list is enclosed herewith. These vacancies
should be filled up immediately by the newly recruited Medical Officers.

Hence, I request that all these newly recruited Doctors may be posted to
the 15 Health Unit Districts only where the vacancy is above 20%. I also submit
that they should be instructed to stay in those Districts for atleast 2 year without
entertaining their requests for transfer.

I request the Government to consider the above proposal for efficient and
smooth functioning of Primary Health Centres which in turn help the rural
people for their betterment of Health.
