ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government have ordered that the pattern of uniforms to the Last Grade Government Servants (Peons, Duffadors and Chubadors) of the Government of Tamil Nadu be as detailed below:

- i) Full Trousers
- ii) Half arm bush shirts
- iii) Plastic badge with appropriate inscriptions and designations of Last Grade Government Servants in the city and davalis and Peak caps for the Last Grade Government servant in the District.

It was also ordered therein that 50% of the number of sets of uniform supplied to Last Grade Government Servants be made of Khadi white drill and the balance 50% of Handloom white drill.

2. Based on the above Government Order at present, the Office Assistants attending on officers in their rooms alone are eligible for uniform. They are supplied 4 sets of cotton uniforms for 2 years or two sets of cotton uniforms for 1 year. The ratio between Handloom and Khadi is 50:50.

3. On various occasions, the proposal for the supply of polyester uniforms, instead of cotton uniforms, was examined, including at the meeting of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services Joint Council held on 17.6.85. The Civil Services Joint Council then decided that the proposal may be examined in the next financial year keeping in view of the financial position obtaining in that year. It was further examined and decided on 16.12.86, 24.6.87, 21.7.87 and 5.12.88 that cotton uniforms may be continued to be supplied to the office assistants attending in Officer's room, in view of the financial constraints.

4. Based on the representation made by the President, Tamil Nadu Office Assistants and Basic Servants State Central Association at the meeting of the Tamil Nadu Civil Services Joint Council held on 5.12.89, it was decided at the meeting to recommend to the Government to supply polyester uniforms once in two years to the Office Assistants attending the rooms of officers instead of cotton uniforms in Khadi and Handlooms once in a year.

5. In the Joint Council meeting held on 1.1.90, it has been decided that the Office Assistants attending Officers may be supplied with one set of Khadi Polyester and one set of Handloom Polyester once in 4 years.

6. The Government after careful consideration, accept the recommendations of the Civil Services Joint Council for supply of Polyester Uniforms to the Office Assistants attending the rooms of Officers in the State Government Offices in Tamil Nadu in the proportion of Khadi/Handloom at 50:50 basis i.e. one set of Handloom white polyester and one set of white Khadi Polyester once in 4 year.

7. The scale of white polyester cloth required to be supplied in Handloom will be 1.75 metre for one full Trousers and 1.60 metre for one bush shirt and Khadi white Polyester cloth will be 1.20 metre for one full Trousers and 1.60 metre for one bush shirt. The uniforms should be supplied after stitching by the Government approved institutions.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of finance vide its U.O.144594/Salaries 11/90-1, dt.18.2.91.
