Abstract:

Establishment--Office of the Director of Public Health--Conversion of certain posts of Superintendents into Superintendents in the Selection Grade--Sanctioned
Read: From the Director of Public Health, R.No.38319/E1/64-4, dated 9.2.1965;

The Director of Public Health in her letter cited has stated that there were two grades of Superintendents in her office prior to 1.6.60 and that the main reasons for constituting two distinct grades of Superintendents in her office on different scales of pay were:

- (i) variations in volume and complexity of work in different sections of the same department; and
- (ii) the fact that one continuous long time scale would not provide adequate incentive for efficient work.

She has also stated that all the posts of Superintendents in her office had to be counted as ordinary unified grade superintendents after the Pay Commission's recommendations. The Director of Public Health has now sent proposals for upgrading five posts out of 21 posts of Superintendents in her office into Selection Grade Superintendents in the Scale of Rs.325-15-400 in order to provide fresh avenues of promotion to the staff and also to remove the present stagnation and create an incentive for rendering more efficient work.

2. After carefully examining the proposals of the Director of Public Health the Government accord sanction temporarily for a period of one year from the date of appointment for upgrading only two posts of Superintendents for the present in her office in to Selection Grade Superintendents in the scale of Rs.325-15-400.

3. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance department- vide its U.O.No.79544 E1/65-1, dated 1.7.1965.
