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Sub: Tamil Nadu Integrated Nutrition Project - Rural Health Services Component - Provision of additional Inputs at the New Health Districts in Madurai District - Sanctioned.

Read: From the Project Co-ordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, Madras D.O.Ir.No.C2/2459/81, dated 22.8.81.

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ORDER

Madurai District is now divided into 3 Health Districts with Headquarters at Madurai, Dindigul and Periakulam. In order to strengthen the health units for effective supervision of all Public Health functionaries and implementation of all Public Health Programmes including Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, sanction of staff and other items of Recurring and Non-Recurring items of expenditure for the purpose, which include among other items Vehicles, Motor Cycles, Duplicators etc. are considered necessary. The Project Coordinator, Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, placed the matter before the Empowered Committee, which met on 10.8.81. The Empowered Committee after considering the proposals has approved them partly.

2. The Government accordingly accorded sanction for the following staff for each of the District Health Offices at Madurai, Dindigul and Periakulam.

Assistant	1 (one)	Rs.400-15-490-20-650-25-700
Junior Assistant	1 (one)	Rs.350-10-420-15-600
Typist	1 (one)	Rs.350-10-420-15-600 + spl. pay.

The staff sanctioned above are eligible to draw Dearness Allowance and other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the orders in force.

Sanction is also accorded for the following items of expenditure

Recurring:

Stationery & Contingencies: Rs.5000/- for each of the 3 Health Districts.

Non-recurring:

Furniture: Rs.5,000/- for each of the 3 Health Districts.

Typewriter: One for each of the 3 Health Districts (to be supplied free of cost by Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras)

Calculators (Pocket size) Two for each of the 3 Health Districts (to be supplied free of cost by Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras)

Duplicator: One for each of the Health Districts at Dindigul and Periakulam (to be supplied free of cost by Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras).

The typewriters should be placed incharge of qualified typists who will be held responsible for their maintenance care and up keep. The Typewriters should be returned to the Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras when such qualified persons cease to be available or for any other reason they are no longer required.

4. The expenditure is debitable to "282.Public Health Sanitation & Water Supply.A.Public Health & Sanitation-AH.Health Education & Publicity Schemes in the Sixth Five Year Plan.II. State Plan-JC-Tamilnadu Nutrition Project - Public Component (DP Code No.282A AHJC 0007).
