ORDER:

In order to copy up with the work of reconciliation of departmental figures of receipts and charges and to propose suitable transfer entries then and there, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine submitted a proposal for the creation of one post of Assistant in each of the 16 Offices of the District Reconciliation Officer in the State as a Part II Scheme for 1984-85.

2. The Government accept the proposals of the Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine and accordingly sanction the creation of one post of Assistant in the scale of pay of Rs.400-15-490-20-650-25-700 for each of the 16 offices of the District Reconciliation Officers under the Directorate of Public Health & Preventive Medicine for the period upto 28.2.1985.

3. Sanction is also recorded to the incurring of the non-recurring expenditure of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) towards the purchase of furniture for the 16 Assistants.

4. The incumbants of the posts sanctioned in para-2 above shall be eligible for the Dearness Allowance and other usual allowances admissible under the orders in force, from time to time.

5. The expenditure should be debited to the head of account "282.A. Public Health and Sanitation - AA. Direction and Administration - Schemes in the Sixth Five Year Plan - II. State Plan-JA. Headquarters Administration - (D.P.Code 282A AAJA 0006)".

6. This order issues with the concurrent of the Finance Department - vide its U.O.No.51734/H&FW/84-1, Health, dated 3-5-1984.
