Hence with an aim of having one Primary Health Centre for every 30,000 population additional Primary Health Centres are being; established in a phased manner and the Primary Health Centres are going up year after year. There are now 652 Primary

Health Centres out of which 216 Primary Health Centres have been ordered to be established during the year 1985-86 alone.
