ORDER:

The Government of India have extended the Universal  
Immunisation Programme in 60 more Districts during 1986-87.  
In Tamil Nadu the following Districts have been selected  
for the implementation of the above programme during 1986-87.

- (1) Periyar District
- (2) Tanjavur District
- (3) Coimbatore.

The Government of India in their letter 2nd read  
above, have conveyed their approval, among others, for  
the creation of the following categories of posts at the  
rate of one in each of the above mentioned Districts.

2. Mechanic	1
3. Typist	1
4. Driver	-

As regards the creation of the posts of drivers the  
Government of India have stated that the Number of posts  
of drivers would be the same as the Number of Vehicles  
sanctioned to the newly selected Districts under the  
programme Based on the concurrence of the Government of  
India, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine  
has forwarded the proposal for the creation of the  
following posts in the Districts of Periyar, Tanjavur and  
Coimbatore under Universal Immunization Programme for 1986-87

1. Statistical Assistant	4
2. Mechanic (Refrigerator)	4
3. Typist	4
4. Drivers	14

The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also stated that even though the Government of India have selected 3 Revenue Districts (viz) Periyar, Tanjavur and Coimbatore there are 4 Health Unit Districts comprised in these 3 Revenue Districts as Tanjavur consists of 2 Health Unit District (i.e.) Tanjavur and Tiruvarur. Hence 4 posts in each category (except driver) instead of 3 have been suggested to be created. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also stated that the Government of India have allotted 14 vehicles under this programme. Hence 14 posts of drivers have also been suggested to be created.

In the circumstances sanction is accorded to the creation temporarily of the following posts during 1986-87 for the implementation of the scheme of Universal Immunisation in the Revenue Health Unit Districts of Periyar, Tanjavur and Coimbatore for a period of one year for the date of employment on the scale of pay noted against each.

1. Statistical Assistant	: 3
2. Mechanic (Refrigerator)	: 3
3. Typist	: 3
4. Drivers	: 14

Regarding the sanction of additional post to the Health Unit District of Tiruvarur the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is informed that the latter is under correspondence with the Government of India and that on receipt of the reply from Government of India, orders will be issued separately.

The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is also informed that the Government of India have agreed to renew the following posts at the state level for 1986-87.

1. Officer-in-charge cold chain : 1
2. Technical Assistant : 1

He is therefore requested to forward necessary proposal for further continuance of the posts sanctioned in the Government Order read above.
