ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, the Government have sanctioned among others the creation of the following posts at District level for the implementation of Universal Immunisation programme in the Districts selected under Universal Immunisation programme during 1935-36 (i.e.) Madurai, Salem and in the Institute of Child Health, Madras, Madurai Medical College, Coimbatore Medical College and Madras Medical College:-

2. In the G.O. 2nd read above, the Government have sanctioned among others the creation of the following posts for the implementation of Universal Immunisation Programme in the Districts selected under Universal Immunisation programme during 1936-37 (i.e.), Periyar, Thanjavur and Coimbatore.

3. Typist ..3 (Three)
4. Drivers 14 (Forteen)

3. During 1937-38, the Government of India have selected North Arcot, South Arcot, Chenglepatu and Dharmapuri for the implementation of Universal Immunisation Programme and conveyed their approval for the creation of the following posts for the above Districts, besides the posts of District Immunisation Officer for the Districts already covered under Universal Immunisation Programme during 1935-36, 1936-37:-

District Immunisation Officer 9 (one for each District of Madurai, Salem, Thanjavur, (Nine) Coimbatore, Periyar, North Arcot, South Arcot, Dharmapuri and Chenglepatu)

Statistical Assistant 4 (one for each District of North Arcot, South Arcot, Dharmapuri and Chenglepatu)

Mechanic (Refrigeration) 4 -do-

Typist 4 -do-

4. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine in his letters read above, has submitted necessary proposal to Government for the creation of the posts mentioned in para 3 above for implementation of Universal Immunisation Programme in this State. The Government accept the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine.

5. Sanction is accorded for the creation of the following posts, temporarily, for the implementation of the Universal Immunisation Programme, for a period upto 29.2.88 from the date of employment.


