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ORDER:

According to the Orders first and second read above Phase III of the Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project will be implemented in all the blocks in Ramanathapuram District and in all blocks except Ponnamaravathy in Pudukottai District. Ramanathapuram District is divided into 3 Health Unit Districts with Headquarters at Ramanathapuram, Karaikudi & Sivakasi. Pudukottai Health District has its Headquarters at Pudukottai. Thus there are 4 Health Unit Districts in these two districts. The Director of Public Health & Preventive Medicine has proposed to strengthen these Health District Units for effective supervision of all Public Health functions and implementation of all Public Health Programme including Tamilnadu Integrated Nutrition Project, under Phase III. He has also requested other items of Recurring and Non-Recurring expenditure like Stationery and contingencies, Furniture, Motor cycles, Vehicles, Duplicators etc. The Project Coordinator has recommended that the pattern of staff and item of expenditure sanctioned for Phase II in Madurai District may be adopted for Phase III also. The Empowered Committee examined the proposals and decided to accept the recommendations of Project Coordinator.

The Government accordingly accord sanction for the following staff for the 4 District Health Offices at Ramanathapuram, Karaikudi, Sivakasi and Pudukottai under Rural Health Services Component for Phase III for a period of One year from the date of appointment.

The staff sanctioned above are eligible to draw Dearness allowance and other allowances at the rates admissible to them under the rules in-force.

Sanction is also accorded for the following items of expenditure:

Recurring: Stationery & Contingences: Rs.5,000/- for each of the 4 Health Unit Districts.

Non-Recurring:-

Furniture: Rs.5,000/- for each of the 4 Health District Unit.

Typewriter: One for each of the 4 Health Districts Unit (to be supplied free of cost by Director of stationery & Printing, Madras)

Calculators: One for each of the 4 Health Districts Unit (to be (Pocket size) supplied free of cost by Director of stationery & Printing, Madras).

Duplicators: One for each of the 4 Health Districts Unit (to be supplied free of cost by Director of Stationery & Printing, Madras.)

The typewriters should be placed incharge of qualified typists who will be held responsible for their maintenance care and upkeep. The Typewriters should be returned to the Director of Stationery and Printing, Madras when such qualified persons cease to be available or for any other reason they are no longer required.
