ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, Government have sanctioned the following temporary staff to the office of the Deputy Director of Health Services, Perambalur for the newly formed Perambalur District.

By upgradation

1. Deputy Director of Health Services - 1 (one)
2. District Malaria Officer (Non-Medical) - 1 (One)

By redeployment/surrender

3. Record Clerk - 1 (One)
4. Administrative Officer - 1(One)
5. Technical Gazetted Personal Assistant - 1 (one)
6. District Public Health Nurse - 1 (One)
7. Assistant - 3 (three)
8. Junior Assistant - 2 (two)
9. Driver - 4 (four)
10. Office Assistant - 2 (two)
11. Office Superintendent - 2 (two)
12. Statistical Assistant - 1 (One)

2. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine in his letter second read above has reported that while sanctioning staff for the newly formed office of the Deputy Director of Health Services Perambalur, the Government have omitted to sanction the following staff:

1. Health officer - 1
2. Typist - 2
3. Refrigerator Mechanic - 1
4. Computer cum vaccine store keeper - 1
5. Media Assistant - 1

3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has reported that the services of Health Officer is essentially required as the Deputy Director of Health Services has to attend various meetings and he has also to conduct review meetings of the Medical Officers, and undertaking tours to inspect the work of the field staff and also during the natural calamities. Hence he has to be assisted by the Health Officer who will reduce the burden of the Deputy Director of Health Services, who can devote more time on planning and implementing the various Public Health Schemes in rural areas. The Services of Typist are required in Deputy Director of Health Services office to attend to the typing and fair copying work of the newly formed Deputy Director of Health Services office. The success of the immunisation programme lies on the maintenance of the cold chain of vaccines stored at various levels for which the Cold storage equipments are always kept in good working conditions. Any failure will lead to loss of potency of vaccines resulting in heavy loss to Government. Hence a Refrigeration Mechanic is absolutely required likewise the post of Computer cum Vaccine Store keeper is also required as he has to attend to the work of stocking vaccines, drugs and equipments etc and distributing them to all the Primary Health Centres in the District. Further, he has to collect reports of maternity and Child health activities, immunisation programme etc. and compile the reports and send to respective officers.

4. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has also reported that for the successful implementation of Public Health activities, there must be public awareness. Hence the Media Assistant plays vital role in creating awareness among the people and convincing them to accept and avail the services under Public Health Programmes. In the above circumstances he has requested the Government to create the staff mentioned in para 2 above. He has also suggested that these posts may be filled up by redeployment.

5. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and they consider that the post of Health Officer is not required as it is not in accordance with the staffing pattern in the office of the Deputy Director of Health Services in other District. Hence, the Government have not accepted the request of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine for creation of one post of Health Officer and to fill up the post on redeployment basis. The Government, however, sanction temporary posts in other categories as detailed in Annexure to this order for a period of one year from the date of their employment to the office of the Deputy Director of Health Services at Perambalur, subject to the condition that the posts should be filled up by redeployment and that the existing staff pattern for Deputy Director of Health Services at Perambalur, subject to the condition that the posts should be filled up by redeployment and that the existing staff pattern for Deputy Director of Health Services office should be adopted and any excess post should be allowed, funds under non-plan. The staff sanctioned will draw D.A. HRA and other allowances as admissible under the rules or orders in force from time to time.
