### **ORDER:**

In the Government order first read above, orders have been issued permitting the Director of Medical Education to select the candidates for admission to Para Medical / Certificate / Diploma / Centres in Medical Record Sciences in Government Medical College / Institutions from the year 2012-2013 session by conducting counseling through selection Committee O/o the Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai.

2. In letters second read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that in various G.O's the Government have permitted 22 Private Para Medical Institutions to start Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) Course of two year duration with an annual intake of 15 students. The admission to the Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology course (DMLT) has been made in their respective private Paramedical Institutions and the names of the selected candidates were registered only during the conduction of examination by the Board of Para Medical Education, King Institute of Preventive Medicine and Research, Guindy, Chennai-32. The Director of Medical Education has put forth the following points for consideration.

- i) At present, the admissions to Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology course is made by the Private Paramedical Institutions during the month of July every year but the approval of Prospectus for admission to Para Medical Courses in Government Medical Colleges is given only after the admission of Private Paramedical Institutions (i.e. July). Hence, the changes that have been incorporated in the Prospectus are not followed by the Private Paramedical Institution.

- ii) In order to avoid selection of candidates who are not eligible to undergo the courses and since the new Prospectus is not received before admission date (i.e. Overage, Higher Secondary course without Science subjects etc) the admission to the Diploma courses in Private Paramedical Institutions (similar to Nursing course) may also be made through counseling under Single Window System along with the other Paramedical Courses at Selection Committee in the Director of Medical Education, Chennai from the year 2013-14 instead of their own Institutions and in order to follow uniformity in regulating the procedures.
- iii) Admission for all the courses including the courses conducted by the Private Paramedical Institutions may be made through counseling under Single Window System under the control of Director of Medical Education i.e., unified under one roof will be more effective and leads smooth functioning of the Department to serve the public.

3. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the application fees of Rs.200/- collected from the candidates applied for the Paramedical courses from the academic year 2014-2015 shall be deposited in the Personal Deposit Account maintained by the Secretary, Selection Committee, Director of Medical Education, Chennai. The Expenditure towards the selection process for the above Diploma courses shall be met from the Personal Deposit Account maintained by the Secretary, Selection Committee, Director of Medical Education, Chennai.

4. The Director of Medical Education has informed that the Board of Para Medical Education, King Institute of Preventive Medicine and Research, Guindy, Chennai has already been entrusted with the works of Registration procedures, training schedules, syllabus requisites, examination formats, conducting examinations, publication of results and issue of the relevant certificates for the above courses conducted by the Private Paramedical Institutions for smooth functioning. The apportionment of seats between Government and management of the private institutions has to be at the ratio of 65:35 and 50:50 in respect of Non Minority and Minority Institutions respectively for the admission to Para Medical courses under single window system.

5. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and entrust the Secretary, Selection Committee O/o Director of Medical Education, Chennai to conduct the counseling under Single Window System for all the courses including Diploma Courses conducted in Private Para Medical Institutions from the academic year 2015-2016 in order to follow uniformity in regulating the procedures and subject to the conditions that the application fee collected from the candidates to be deposited in the Personal Deposit Account of the Director of Medical Education and the expenditure towards the selection process to be met from the Personal Deposit Account. The Government also direct that and the apportionment of seats between Government and management of the private institutions will be 65:35 in case of Non-Minority Institutions and 50:50 in case of Minority Institutions as per the Tamil Nadu admission in professional Educational institutions Act 2006 followed for the Professional Educational courses.




