ORDER:

In the Government Order second read above, orders have been issued permitting the Director of Family Welfare to pay Rs.300/- as beneficiary compensation to the Post Partum Intra Uterine Contraceptive Device (PPIUCD) acceptors with effect from 01.04.2017 as per Government of India guidelines in addition to the payment of Rs.150/- per case as incentive to the service providers for PPIUCD insertion.

2. The Director of Family Welfare has stated that based on the guidelines of Government of India in its letter dated 29.03.2017, sanction order is necessary with permission to pay Rs.300/- to the PAIUCD acceptors and Rs.150/- for PAIUCD incentive to the service providers with effect from 01.04.2017. He has also stated that the Government of India has approved Rs.9 lakh under National Health Mission Tamil Nadu State under Programme Implementation Plan for the year 2017-2018 towards 2000 number of PAIUCD insertions at Rs.150/- per case as incentive for service providers and Rs.300/- per case as beneficiary compensation.

3. The Director of Family Welfare has requested the Government to issue sanction order permitting the Director of Family Welfare to implement the scheme and pay beneficiary compensation for PAIUCD insertion at Rs.300/- (with effect from 01.04.2017) per case and a sum of Rs. 150/- per case as incentive to the service providers for

PAIUCD insertion. Funds will be released by the State Health Society out of the amount approved by the Government of India in the Programme Implementation Plan for 2017 - 2018 duly after the sanction order is issued.

4. The Government after careful examination has decided to accept the above proposal and accordingly grant permission to the Director of Family Welfare to pay Rs.300/- per case to the PAIUCD acceptors as beneficiary compensation and a sum of Rs.150/- as incentive to the service providers for PAIUCD insertion following induced (surgical) or spontaneous abortions only (not for the Medical Methods of Abortion) with effect from 01.04.2017. He is also permitted to utilize the funds released by the Mission Director, State Health Society for the year 2017-2018 as approved by the Government of India in the Programme Implementation Plan for 2017-2018.
