Medical Education – Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship Training – Revising the existing norms for Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship (CRRI) training of final year MBBS students of Self Financing Private Medical College students as well as Foreign Medical Graduates - Orders – Issued.

ORDER :-

In Government order first read above, the Government issued the following orders:-

- a. Ceiling of 5% for CRRI training was fixed long time back and at present there are 12 Government Medical Colleges and 3 Self financing Medical Colleges. Hence the 5% ceiling already fixed is removed.
- b. A ban is imposed on the transfer of students to undergo their CRRI training from one Government Medical College to other Government Medical College in the State. The students where they study should complete their CRRI training at their college itself.
- c. With reference to the transfer of candidates for CRRI training the distribution should be equal in city Medical Colleges Viz Madras Medical College, Chennai, Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai and Stanley Medical College, Chennai.
- d. A separate registers would be maintained by the Government for the above purpose.

2. In Government order second read above, the Government among others fixed fee structure, for pursuing CRRI training in Tamil Nadu as detailed below:-

Candidates from Foreign Countries	-	Rs.2,00,000/-
Candidates from other State	-	Rs.1,00,000/- for Government Colleges and Rs.3,00,000/- for Private Colleges
Candidates from other Private Medical Colleges within Tamil Nadu	-	Rs.2,00,000/-

3. In Government order third read above, the Government stopped permission for pursuing internship training for outside CRRI Candidates who completed their MBBS Degree course in Self Finance Private Medical Colleges / Deemed to be Universities affiliated by MCI and Foreign Medical Graduates in the following 7 Government Medical Colleges:-

1. Madras Medical College, Chennai.
2. Stanley Medical College, Chennai.
3. Govt. Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai.
4. Madurai Medical College, Madurai.
5. Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College, Salem.
6. Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore.
7. Tirunelveli Medical College, Tirunelveli.

4. The Director of Medical Education in the letter fourth read above, has stated that as of now the daily Covid cases are reaching alarming proportions and with the increased mortality rate and that there is an urgent need to initiate pandemic mitigation efforts to overcome the current situation. He has therefore requested the Government to issue orders on the following:-

- i. to permit him to issue No Objection Certificate for CRRIIs (from other States, Private Colleges, other universities & Foreign Medical Graduates without upper ceiling limit, as the Tamil Nadu Medical Council letter Dated: 15.04.2021 has informed that "All Medical Colleges can issue No objection certificate to Foreign Medical Graduate & other state students after ensuring that , the admission for CRRI does not exceed 10% sanctioned strength of the MBBS allotted by the National Medical Council."
- ii. to permit him to issue No Objection Certificate to Foreign Medical Graduates to undergo CRRI in Government medical colleges without obtaining NOC from the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University since the processing fees collected by the University was huge financial burden to the Foreign Medical Graduates, further Foreign Medical College students doing internship in Government Medical College Hospitals has not under the purview of the Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University and many foreign CRRIIs are avoiding Director of Medical Education side training for this huge amount;
- iii. to permit him to collect a fees of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs only) as per the G.O.(D) No.1258 , Health & Family Welfare (MC2), Department, 20.11.2014 from each Foreign Medical Graduate out of which Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakhs only) to be remitted to the colleges and Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakhs only) to the PD account of Selection Committee from the CRRI students from other private institutions/other states including Foreign Medical Graduates willing to undergo CRRI training in Government Medical Colleges; and
- iv. to remove the ban imposed by the Government in G.O.(Ms)No.594 , Health & Family Welfare (MCA-1), Department, Dated 28.12.2018 to the above said seven Government Medical Colleges for doing CRRI training.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal, hereby permit the Director of Medical Education for the following:-

- i. to issue No Objection Certificate to Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship students from other States, Private Colleges, other universities and Foreign Medical Graduates to undergo their Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship Training at Government Medical Colleges without any ceiling, so as to handle the present prevailing pandemic situation.
- ii. to follow present procedure for collection of fees from the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship students of other States, Private Colleges, other universities & Foreign Medical Graduates to undergo their Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship Training at Government Medical Colleges.
- iii. to revive and to allow Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internship students in the following seven Medical Institutions as a onetime measure for this year only so as to handle the present prevailing pandemic situation, subject to the other conditions mentioned in Government order first read above:-
 - (1) Madras Medical College, Chennai.
 - (2) Stanley Medical College, Chennai.
 - (3) Government Kilpauk Medical College, Chennai.
 - (4) Madurai Medical College, Madurai.
 - (5) Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College, Salem.
 - (6) Coimbatore Medical College, Coimbatore.
 - (7) Tirunelveli Medical College, Tirunelveli.

6. The Director of Medical Education and the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University are directed to pursue further action accordingly.
